It's very rare that Lowerhouse reach the month of May without playing a home game but that has been the case this year. The team had a relatively comfortable win at Rishton last week with our old friend Joe Hawke deputising as sub-pro. Jon Finch with the ball and Ben Heap with the bat were the stars of the show. Rishton are relatively moderate and this week-end will be a proper test of where we are. Firstly we jump from the frying pan that is Todmorden to the fire, when we visit title favourites Ramsbottom tomorrow.

Today's visitors Todmorden produced an excellent win against a strong Accrington side last Sunday in what was a rain affected match at Centre Vale. Many 'House fans consider Centre Vale as a favourite ground even though some of us risked being drowned when being confronted with flash floods there a few years ago. The good news is that we have two visits to Tod this season as we play there in the Worsley Cup first round. Todmorden have a strong record in the Cup in recent years although they have fallen at the final hurdle 3 times since beating Haslingden in the 2,000 Final.

The club's league record is less enviable and it is now 53 years since they bagged league honours. In that1957 season Jim Minhas, a player associated and well-remembered in 'House circles, was the Tod professional. Todmorden have been runners-up 3 times since 1957. The last of those occasions was particularly heart-breaking. With Aussie Darryl Scott as pro Tod and Nelson tied for the 1986 League Championship and a play-off game was arranged on the neutral territory of Turf Moor.

Both regular professionals were unavailable and the men from Seedhill won a tense game by 13 runs. None of the Tod batsmen could play a telling enough innings as the game ended in the near darkness of late September. With the legendary Ibra Ali back in the fold it will be interesting to see if today's visitors can end their long drought. Every other Lancashire League team has won the league title since Todmorden and that has to hurt at proud Centre Vale.
