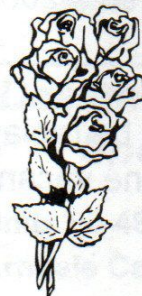

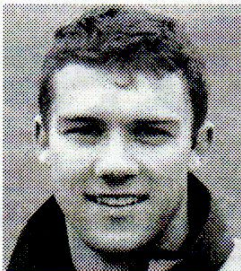

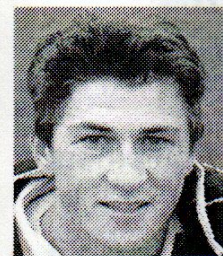

### League Rules - Rain-affected matches

1. If rain stops play during the first innings of a match, each side loses one over for every 7 minutes time lost; if the delay is during the second innings, one over is lost for every 3½ minutes.
2. The side batting second must be able to receive 25 overs if the following run-rate rules are to apply.
3. If there is not time for 25 overs in the second innings, but both captains agree a definite result can be reached without the run-rate rules, then the game can continue. If the captains do not agree, then the game can still continue if one captain and both umpires believe a result can be achieved.
4. Run-rate rules: when overs are lost during the second innings, the target is reduced by only three-quarters of the run-rate of the side batting first. For example, if the side batting first scored 200 from 50 overs, ie. 4 runs per over, and then 10 overs are lost, the target is reduced by:  
$$10 \text{ overs} \times 4 \text{ runs per over} \times \frac{3}{4} = 30$$
and the new target is 171 instead of 201.
5. If rain is threatening, the 'simplest' way to at least estimate which side is in front is as follows:
  - (i) work out the average run rate scored in the first innings, and multiply it by three quarters.
  - (ii) work out the run-rate required in what is left of the second innings.
  - (iii) compare the two - the side with the lower number is ahead. Wickets do not come into account.
6. Example: Suppose Colne make 250 from 50 overs, and Lowerhouse are 171 with 20 overs left.
  - (i) Colne scored 250 in 50, 5 runs per over,  $\times \frac{3}{4} = 3.75$ .
  - (ii) Lowerhouse need 80 from 20 overs = 4.00.
  - (iii) Colne would win on run rate if it rained now.
7. Failing that, ask me (David Roe) or hope it stays fine!

#### Worsley Cup rules:

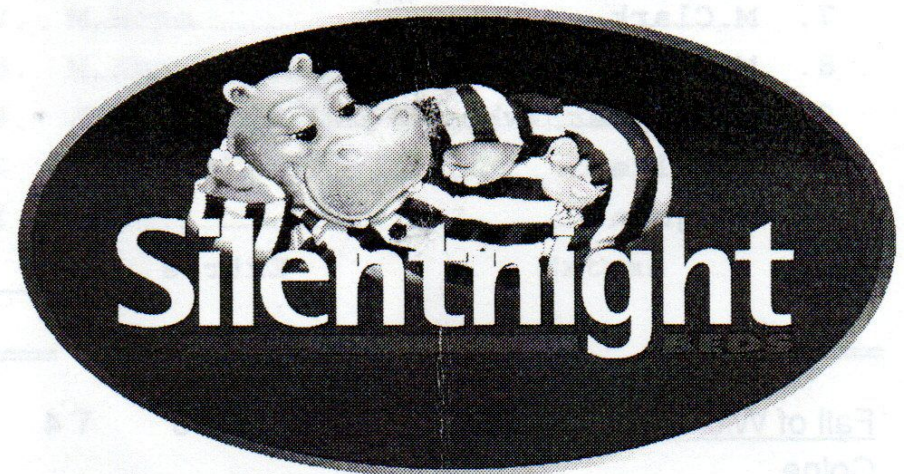
1. 50 overs per side, 10 overs maximum per bowler.
2. Fielding circle - only 2 players outside the circle for the first 15 overs; only 5 players outside the circle thereafter.
3. If the match is tied, the side losing fewer wickets will win. If still tied, the side with the higher score after 40 overs, then if still tied 30 overs, then 20 overs, then 10 overs.
4. Wides - the leg side wides rule does apply, under the same rule as in league games.
5. Admission (set by the league) is £4 adults, £2 concessions; gate money is shared by the two clubs.

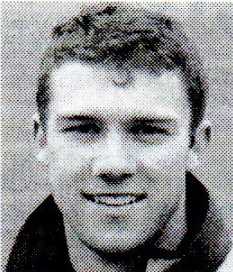
