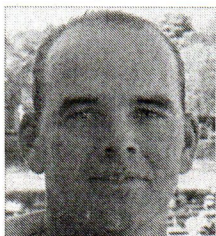

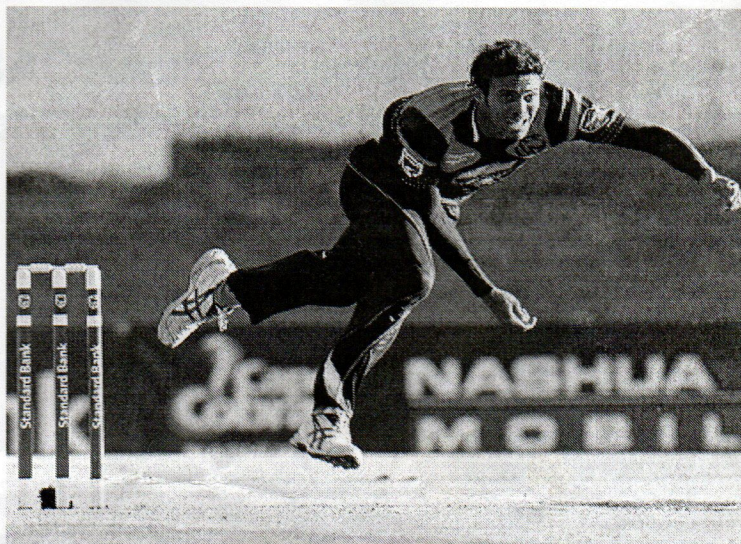

Lowerhouse's Professional - Francois Haasbroek



Francois is in his second season with Lowerhouse, having made a major contribution to their title campaign last year with 700 runs and 35 wickets. He is a right handed batsman and fast-medium bowler. He now plays for North West in South Africa.

The New Professional - Shadley van Schalkwyk

Shadley is a 23 year old left handed batsman and right arm medium-fast bowler from Cape Town.

In 34 first class matches he has scored 755 runs (4 fifties) at an average of 26 and taken 65 wickets at 36 each, but it is in one-day cricket that he has so far excelled. He has scored 388 runs at average 24, but has taken 63 wickets at only 19.95 each, with 3 4-wicket innings - best bowling 5-30.

He was a former team-mate of Francois Haasbroek at Free State, until Haasbroek moved to North West last winter.
