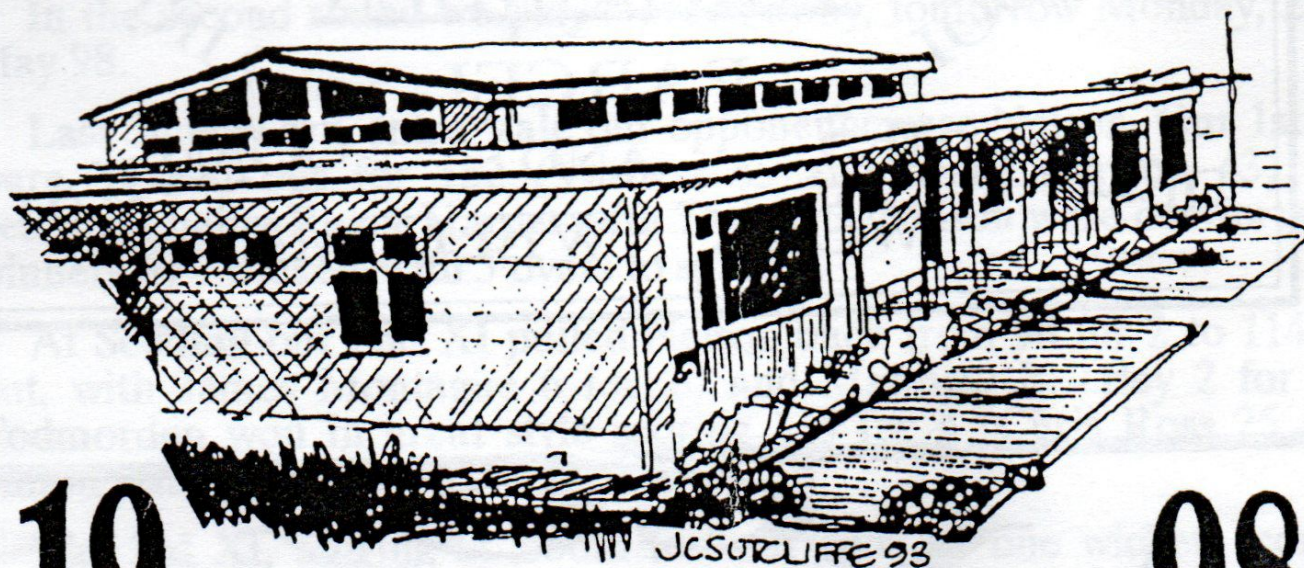

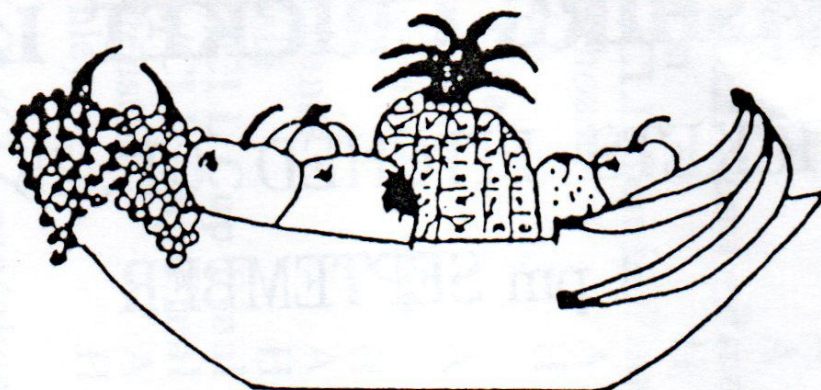

Club News

The excellent cup results have boosted the confidence of our 1st XI. When our 1st Round Worsley Cup Tie resumed on the Monday evening Rawtenstall were in a good position to win but our bowlers performed well in the gloom, the score being 127 for 4 when play was again suspended. The following evening Vasbert, helped by David Whitehead, removed Keith Artherton in the first over and our amateurs then bowled tightly to secure a 31 run victory.

At Middleton in the inter-league cup our score of 249 for 7 in the 45 overs (spearheaded by David Whitehead's 48 and Vasbert's 74) proved too much for the home side, who were all out in the last over for 218. It was a good day's cricket and Middleton's friendship and hospitality were excellent.

In the second round we play Norden away, tomorrow Monday, 25th May 98.

Last Sunday at Centre Vale our opponents were Nelson. Our 1st XI were bowled out for 152 (Vasbert 65 and Mark Clayton 43) the destroyer being Roger Harper with 7 wickets. Nelson were comfortable winners by 7 wickets with 5 overs to spare.

At Seedhill our 2nd XI pulled Nelson back from 98 for 2 to 114 all out, with James Montague 6 for 10 and Matthew Brierley 2 for 13. Todmorden won in great style scoring 115 for 4 (Chris Ross 25 and Simon Barker 56 not out) with 20 overs left.

The 3rd XI, playing at Booth lost narrowly by one wicket, scoring 167 all out to Booth's 170 for 9.

Matthew Mott : age 24 : Lowerhouse Professional

Matthew is a top order left-handed batsman from Queensland, who succeeded Daniel Marsh, Todmorden's 1996 professional, as captain of the celebrated Australian Cricket Academy in 1995-96. He broke the Academy batting record in scoring almost 1000 runs for the season including five centuries.

He made his debut for Queensland in 1994/5 in the same match as a previous Lowerhouse professional Shaun Flegler.

Matthew is no stranger to the League having been professional at Church in 1996, when he scored 1097 runs, and took 43 wickets with his right arm medium paced bowling.

In 1994 he had an outstanding season as an amateur with Porthill in the North Staffordshire League scoring over 1000 runs with an average of 108.

The New Playing Format for League Matches

- 1 Each match consists of 100 overs.
- 2 The side batting first may bat up to 55 overs but can declare its innings closed at any time.
- 3 The side batting second has a minimum of 45 overs plus any of the 100 overs left from the first innings.
- 4 An outright win gains 10 points; a draw 2 points; and a tie 5 points.
- 5 During the second innings:
 - the batting side gains 2 bonus points for achieving 90% of the first team's score;
 - the fielding side gains 1 bonus point for taking 5 wickets and 1 more bonus point for 7 wickets.
- 6 If, in a rain affected match, there is not time to bowl 40 overs, the match is abandoned.
- 7 Any team which does not bowl a minimum of 16 overs per hour may have 1 point deducted for each match in which **this occurs.**

Lowerhouse

40 years ago

In 1958 Todmorden and Lowerhouse finished equal eleventh with identical records – 3 wins, 16 draws and 7 defeats. There was hardly any play when the sides met. Rain caused a complete abandonment at West End, and Todmorden were 27 for 0 when rain stopped play at Centre Vale. Lowerhouse had not won on Todmorden's ground since 1912 – they next won here in 1961.

25 years ago

Ninth placed Todmorden met eleventh placed Lowerhouse three times in the first twelve matches of 1973. The first round cup tie at Lowerhouse lasted just 22.1 overs, as the home side collapsed from 16 for 0 to 29 all out, which remains the lowest score in a cup tie involving Todmorden. Professional Peter Marner took 7 for 14 and Brian Whittaker 2 for 3. Todmorden knocked off the runs for the loss of one wicket in 5 overs, Marner 22 not out.

Lowerhouse took revenge three weeks later. 36 from Phil Astin and 29 by Tony Benneworth enabled the home side to reach 109 all out, Marner taking 3 for 39. Todmorden never recovered from 30 for 6 and were bundled out for 69, West Indian professional Duncan Carter taking 6 for 27 and Trevor Jones 3 for 14. Skipper Jim Clayton top-scored for Todmorden with 24.

An over-cautious approach cost Lowerhouse victory at Centre Vale. Mick Swift (46), Astin (39), Benneworth (39) and Carter (33) all batted well, but a declaration at 184 for 7 left under two hours to force a result. Peter Marner hit 25 but a late collapse to Carter (4 for 57) and Jones (4 for 9) left Todmorden hanging on for a draw at 87 for 9. Clayton (25 not out) and John Townend survived a tense final over.

10 years ago

Both matches between Lowerhouse (seventh) and Todmorden (twelfth) were no results in 1988. At West End, Lowerhouse had recovered from 42 for 3 to 78 for 3, with professional Manzoor Elahi looking threatening when the rains came.

51 for Elahi and 53 from Stan Heaton (one of his five half centuries in this fixture) put Lowerhouse in a strong position at Centre Vale, but 5 for 47 by Sherlon Greaves, Todmorden professional, restricted the visitors to 167 for 7. Todmorden were cruising to victory at 90 for 0 after 20 overs, with Ian Smith on 33 and Albert Ross 36, when rain again ended play prematurely.

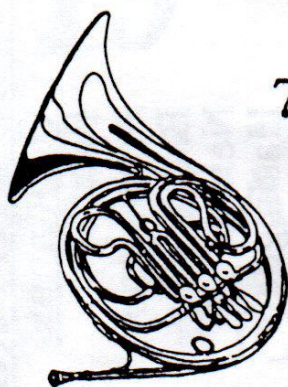
